

Safeguarding at Maryport Infant School



What do we do to ensure safeguarding is effective and our pupils are safe?

- ✓ A dedicated safeguarding team is in place and meetings take place every other Friday.
- ✓ There is a designated safeguarding governor.
- ✓ All staff wear identity badges
- ✓ All visitors sign in and wear a visitor's badge.
- ✓ Registers are taken twice daily – children sign in and out if leaving early for appointments etc.
- ✓ Attendance is monitored daily and first day calling procedures are in place.
- ✓ The head teacher oversees all health care plans and administration of medicines.
- ✓ All staff and governors are trained in level 1 safeguarding.
- ✓ All staff have current DBS checks
- ✓ Twice weekly nurture group for KS1 and daily Nurture Group for EYFS ran by fully trained Nurture Group accredited staff.
- ✓ Cumbria LSCB Early Help process followed.
- ✓ Safer recruitment protocols in place.
- ✓ All staff have regular training and have completed modules on Prevent, FGM and CSE.
- ✓ Staff and governors are trained in safer recruitment (Safeguarding Suite module)
- ✓ DSL and Deputy DSL trained to level 2 and 3 safeguarding.
- ✓ Strong multi-agency approach – Police, young Carers, Barnardos and other schools
- ✓ Kidsafe Registered school
- ✓ Pupils receive safety within the computing curriculum.
- ✓ The school site is secure from 9am – 3pm.
- ✓ Safeguarding concerns are logged by all members of staff and monitored by DSLs/safeguarding team using CPOMS.
- ✓ DSLs have opportunities for supervision when needed.
- ✓ All pupils are plotted on the “wedge” model to identify need.
